Dear Friend of Jesus King of All Nations,

Under the direction of Pope Benedict XVI, the Catholic Church held the first World Apostolic Congress on Mercy in Rome in April 2008, to energize, educate and enable attendees to return to their homelands and spread the message of Divine Mercy.

We have witnessed many changes throughout the world since then. Wars and acts of terrorism continue, natural disasters have claimed the lives of tens of thousands and acts of greed and corruption have caused economic chaos. When we don't pray and implore God's Mercy, we are vulnerable to receive His Justice. Is God's justice at hand?

Was the Japanese Earthquake/Tsunami/Nuclear Disaster Heaven's Punishment?

The Governor of Tokyo, Shintaro Ishihara, said that the Japanese Earthquake/Tsunami/Nuclear Dis-



aster was “punishment from heaven” because Japanese have become greedy. He also said, “Japanese politics is tainted with egoism and populism. We need to use the tsunami to wipe out egoism, which has attached itself like rust to the mentality of the Japanese people over a long period of time.”

Was the Governor right? We don't know and leave it to the mystery of God's sovereign providence. But does God really punish us? Of course, what father does not punish his children out of love for them? “For whom the Lord loves, He disciplines.” (Hebrews 12:6). “Whomever is dear to me I reprove and chastise.” (Revelation 3:19).

A chastisement is a punishment allowed by God in order to bring His loved ones to repentance. There are many examples of chastisements in the Bible such as the Great Flood, the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah and the destruction of Jerusalem that Jesus prophesied.

However, **God's chastisements are not vengeful but merciful.** “This is not a vengeance that God

exacts against us, but a warning inflicted by the Lord on those who are near His heart.” (Judith 8:25-27).

God allows chastisements to warn us and awaken our consciences; to bring us to turn to Him; to allow us to participate in His redemptive suffering; to give us an opportunity to pray and perform acts of mercy; to bring down His great mercy upon us and to allow us to serve His divine plan of love. **Now it is up to us to perform the spiritual work of mercy to pray for the Japanese that God’s great Mercy will come upon them and allow them to serve His divine plan of love.**

Let us pray that the prayers to Jesus King of All Nations will bring them the hope and consolation that He promises. **In the past, Jesus King of All Nations, has warned us of chastisements and given us what He calls “the great remedy” against them, which is His devotion. To those who practiced the Devotion, He spared or averted chastisements. He said to those who practiced His devotion, “I have shown them that if they turn to me, their Merciful King who desires to reign in their hearts, that I am a King of Mercy, a Father of Mercy, a Lord of Love....”**

Puerto Rican Tsunami: SPARED

In 1993, Jesus King of All Nations prophesied a tsunami in Puerto Rico from which they were spared because the faithful responded and prayed the Devotional prayers. Jesus showed His mercy. He said,

My message was received with an open heart and with an open soul. And they did not receive you with scorn or indifference or mock the messages that I have sent, or refuse to listen! I have shown them that if they turn to me, their Merciful King who desires to reign in their hearts, that I am a King of Mercy, a Father of Mercy, a Lord of Love who does not want their unnecessary deaths and condemnation of their souls because of

their sins and stubbornness in pride.

After Puerto Rico was spared, Jesus said, “Have no doubt — the thunder of my justice was going to be heard. . . . It is you my special little ones who have found the fulfillment of My promises not only for yourselves, but for your whole nation! Remember what I have done for you My people, of how I have spared you this time!”

Hurricane Charley: AVERTED

It was 3:30 p.m. on Friday, August 14, 2004 during the hour of Mercy. I gathered with my staff in our chapel in our Vermont apostolate center. We turned to St. Michael and prayed, “*St. Michael, Great Prince and Guardian of your people, come with the holy angels and saints and protect us!*” We also prayed the Chaplet of Unity for protection and the Chaplet of Mercy for the victims. Hurricane Charley was approaching directly upon our small branch office in a mobile home park in Nokomis, on the west coast of Florida.

Jesus King of All Nations promised for those who practice His Devotion “protection in times of harm and danger. This will especially be true of danger coming from natural disasters.” This was certainly a danger from a natural disaster and we prayed in earnest for protection of our office.

As we prayed, the hurricane inexplicably took a right turn, and at 3:45 p.m. it hit land with a ferocious force just 25 miles south of our office. The hurricane totally wiped out many mobile home parks but left ours with just a little wind and rain. Not even a branch fell! And The Weather Channel reported that Hurricane Charley inexplicably changed course right at that time.

I attribute this protection to Jesus King of All Nations and to St. Michael. I encourage you to buy *The Journal* and read all of Jesus’ promises for protection and to wear His medal. **Many more natural disasters will be coming as God continues to warn humanity of its errant ways and speaks to us loudly through the voice of nature.**

Asian Tsunami: NOT SPARED

On December 26, 2005, the Asian Tsunami struck. There was no sparing. Jesus had warned on August 25, 2004 that, “*A most fearful punishment is close at hand. Cities will be simultaneously affected. Great destruction. Great loss of life. Great sorrow and pain. Smoke and fire. Wailing and lamentation.*”

Two days after the Asian tsunami struck, on December 28, 2005, Jesus said,

I have shaken the earth to awaken the conscience of man. Will they hear? Will they wake from their sleep in sin? If they do not, a yet more terrible catastrophe will befall mankind. Pray! Sacrifice! Invoke My Most Sacred, Eucharistic and Kingly Heart through My Most Holy Mother!

Child, I have given a GREAT REMEDY in My Devotion of Jesus, King of All Nations. I ask My children to embrace this Devotion. To pray this Devotion. To invoke Me as Jesus, King of All Nations. My Mercy and Protection will cover those souls, families and nations that invoke Me thus. . . .

Children, My children, do not despair. . . Come to My Throne of Mercy, confident that I will hear you. I reign in the Most Blessed Sacrament. Adore Me there. Receive Me with hearts full of love and submission to My Holy Will. I need you My faithful ones. Help Me to save souls. . . .

Pray for Merciful Protection From Chastisements

Jesus implores us and tells us that He *needs* us! Let us pray for Jesus’ merciful protection from chastisements. Please help me to promote and spread the Devotion to Jesus King of All Nations

Be Merciful

In his first encyclical, *Deus Caritas Est (God is Love)*, Pope Benedict invites us to recall, “St. Augustine who gives us faith’s answer to our sufferings: ‘If you understand Him, He is not God’.” **The Holy Father adds: “Even in their bewilderment and failure to understand the world around them, Christians continue to believe in the ‘goodness and loving kindness of God’.”** (Titus 3:4). (No. 38).

Jesus is Merciful. He calls us to also be merciful. He revealed the merciful intentions that He desires for those who pray the Chaplet of Unity as follows:

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| Sunday: | The Holy Father, the Bishops and the Priests |
| Monday: | The Poor Souls |
| Tuesday: | The Promoters of the Devotion |
| Wednesday: | The Hopeless People |
| Thursday: | Reverence to Jesus in the Eucharist |
| Friday: | No one to die in vain |
| Saturday: | The Proclamation of the Dogma of Mary, Mediatrix of All Graces |

Jesus once spoke of the Devotion saying, “*My little one, I will work wonders through this Devotion to Me as ‘Jesus King of All Nations.’*” Will you pray and show us your mercy by your financial support? Without your companionship in our apostolate, we cannot continue to spread the Devotion as Jesus so desires. Please help us to continue our work so that Jesus will work more and more wonders in our lives, our families, our nation and throughout the world!

The Chaplet of Unity

The Chaplet is recited on ordinary rosary beads. Groups may divide the recitation between Leader (L) and Responders (R). If you are alone recite both parts. Recite on the large bead before each of five decades:

L: God our Heavenly Father, through Your Son Jesus, our Victim-High Priest, True Prophet, and Sovereign King,

R: Pour forth the power of Your Holy Spirit upon us and open our hearts. In Your Great Mercy, through the Motherly Mediation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our Queen, forgive our sinfulness, heal our brokenness, and renew our hearts in the faith, and peace, and love, and joy of Your Kingdom, that we may be one in You.

Recite on the ten small beads of each of the five decades:

L: In Your Great Mercy,

R: Forgive our sinfulness, heal our brokenness, and renew our hearts that we may be one in You.

Conclude in unison:

Hear, O Israel! The Lord Our God is One God!

Oh Jesus, King of All Nations, may Your reign be recognized on Earth!

Mary, Our Mother and Mediatrix of All Grace, pray and intercede for us your children!

St. Michael, Great Prince and Guardian of Your People, come with The Holy Angels and Saints and Protect Us!
