Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary May 31, 2011

“When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the infant leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit, cried out in a loud voice and said, ‘Most blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb. And how does this happen to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?’”
(Luke 1:41-43).

Dear Friend of Jesus King of All Nations,

Mary's elderly, pregnant cousin, St. Elizabeth, was the first to recognize her Lord, Jesus Christ, when Mary, her younger pregnant cousin, visited her with the unborn Christ child in her womb.

This awesome event was the first Visitation of Jesus King of All Nations! Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit and recognized at that moment that Mary's unborn child was her Lord. As Elizabeth recognized Him at His Visitation, so too should we should recognize Him as He visits us today through His Visitation Image.

Our failure to recognize Him today, may lead us to suffer from His chastisement, as did those who failed to recognize the day of His Visitation on earth and suffered from the destruction of Jerusalem. As Jesus drew near to Jerusalem, He saw the city and wept over it. He said, “If this day you only knew what makes for peace — but now it is hidden from your eyes. For the days are coming upon you when your enemies will raise a palisade against you; they will en-

circle you and hem you in on all sides. They will smash you to the ground and your children within you, and they will not leave one stone upon another within you because you did not recognize the time of your visitation.” (Luke 19:42-44). This prophecy of Jesus was fulfilled by the destruction of Jerusalem and its Temple in the year 70 A.D. by the Roman General Titus.

Likewise, for our times, Jesus told St. Faustina, “**Woe to them if they do not recognize this time of My visitation.**” (Diary 1160). So, to prevent chastisements, let us recognize this time of His visitation and pray the prayer that Jesus revealed, “**O Jesus King of All Nations may Your reign be recognized on earth!**”

We recognize His reign on the journey of the Visitation Image of Jesus King of All Nations. New Hampshire Visitation

Guardian Juanita Sweet reported on the Visitation of Jesus King of All Nations to Charlestown, NH last November:

We are so very thankful here at All Saints Parish for being so blessed as to have the Holy Visitation Image of Jesus King of All Nations visit us! Praise God!

What a tremendous grace this was indeed! So many of our parishioners were so moved and transfixed by the Image of Our Lord. So many spoke of how very present He was to them. I was told so many times of how His gentle face touched them and gave them peace. Many of our parishioners just wanted to touch the Image and feel His presence! It was so beautiful witnessing the joy and peace on their faces!

We were so graced to have the Image on the Feast of Christ the King! Our pastor, Father Michael, was visibly on fire as he spoke to us that day with the Image to his left. He pointed to it and spoke of the power of God's love and mercy and how He wants to bless and heal us.

One of our parishioners had this to say about Our Lord's special visit: "What awe to be in the presence of the Jesus King of All Nations Image and an intense desire to praise and thank this Most Holy King of Mercy! How blessed our parish was to have had this heavenly visitor."

One young mother whose husband had little work and little income for their family of six was in deep prayer before the Image after Mass one Sunday. After we all left the church, I went into the local supermarket and met a woman who said that her daughter and husband wanted to adopt a family for Christmas and did I know of one. I immediately thought of this young mother that I had just seen. So I called her and asked her if she would be willing to have this couple adopt her fam-

ily for Christmas. She immediately began to cry and answered with a resounding "yes", thank you Jesus!

She told me it was a miracle and an answer to her prayers because she didn't know what she and her husband were going to be able to give their children for Christmas. She asked me when the woman saw me and I told her immediately after I had left the church. The mother told me that at the same time she had just asked Our Lord for that intention when she was praying at His Image. How powerful He is! How powerful and loving and merciful He is!!!

I know there were so many who were so blessed and that God accomplished what He had come to do through the presence of His Image and I cannot thank you enough for the extreme privilege of having it grace our parish!

Priest's Testimony on Visitation of Jesus King of All Nations

Father Michael Gendron, pastor of All Saints parish in Charlestown, NH testified:

As for my thoughts on the Jesus King of All Nations Visitation — simply, Jesus comes to those who He knows needs His tender mercy and healing. He comes to those He knows are open to his living grace which He gives without limit. He comes to those who are searching for answers only He can provide. And He comes to open hearts to the will of His heavenly Father.

Jesus King of All Nations Image

The Image of Jesus King of All Nations shows Him crowned as King holding a scepter of mercy in His right hand. Above the scepter are three concentric rings, as in an atom, which symbolize unity in God, in

His Church, in nations and in Him. The small particle in the atom symbolizes the Church and Our Lady, both espoused to God. Rays of light shine from His wounds which symbolize His merciful graces. Blood flows from His wounded Sacred Heart upon all nations which symbolizes His love.

Jesus said, *“This Image is a sign that I rule Heaven and earth, and My Kingdom, My reign, is near at hand. Give this Image to mankind as a source of graces and of peace. My Most Holy Mother is preparing the great triumph. The triumph of her Immaculate Heart ushers in the Reign of My Love and Mercy. This Image, My child, must become known. Tremendous will be the miracles of grace that I will work through this Image and Devotion of Mine.”*

Jesus asked us in this devotion, ***“My children, come before My Image and pray for your countries. Pray for your people. Pray for your families. Pray for My Mercy which I will graciously grant to those peoples and nations that acknowledge Me as True King!”***

This Image of Jesus King of All Nations has journeyed throughout the world and has been venerated by hundreds of thousands. Many signs, wonders, healings and conversions have been reported by people who have prayed the devotional prayers.

Jesus revealed that this devotion is to be a companion devotion to the Sacred Heart Devotion given to Saint Margaret Mary and the Divine Mercy Devotion given to Saint Faustina. He said, ***“The end goal of this devotion, and indeed of all devotions, is that of true love and worship of Me, your God and the sanctification and resulting salvation of your souls.”***



Host a Parish Visitation

If you would like to host a Visitation of the Image of Jesus King of All Nations, please call Johane at our office at 800-958-4499.



A Visitation consists of visits of the Image to different sites and promotion of the Jesus King of All Nations Devotion to bring the recognition of the reign of Jesus King of All Nations to earth.

If you request to be a Guardian for a Visitation, you will be asked to commit yourself to a Visitation. The Visitation will then be confirmed. You must then form a Guardian Team to plan and implement the Visitation including the sites; the liturgies, hours of veneration, the publicity and the distribution of the religious goods.

Host a Home Visitation

Perhaps Jesus King of All Nations is calling you now to host a Home Visitation for Him.



The format consists of the following:

1. A viewing of a video of a TV interview with Dan Lynch which explains the Devotion and its fruits of conversions, signs and wonders.
2. Praying the prayers of the Devotion in front of His Image.
3. Offering for sale the devotional religious goods.

We will ship a 2' x 3' Image and the religious goods to you on consignment. All you do is invite ten to twenty people to your home or group, show the video, lead the prayers and offer the religious goods. Then you return what's leftover to us. It's simple and easy.
