"I AM THE GUARDIAN OF THE MOST BLESSED SACRAMENT!"

Dear Friend of Jesus King of All Nations,

On this great Feast of St. Michael the Archangel, we are reminded of the apparition of St. Michael to Jesus' Secretary. St. Michael revealed that it was the Most Holy Will of God that he be honored as the Protector of the Church of Christ on Earth and Guardian of the Most Blessed Sacrament.

St. Michael told Jesus' Secretary, ***"Let souls turn to me for renewed devotion to our Lord in this Blessed Sacrament! He must be properly adored, loved, thanked, praised and worshipped in this the Most Glorious Sacrament."***

Jesus' Secretary said, "After St. Michael had said this, I saw him gaze up to Heaven at the God he so loves and defends, with reverence, 'O God, who is like unto thee?' (Psalm 70:19) and a tremendous look that denoted great love, 'Blessed are all they that love thee...' (Tobias 13:18) loyalty, and an overpowering sense of awe."

Jesus King of All Nations gave us St. Michael as an intercessor and protector, to draw us closer to Him in the 'Most Glorious Sacrament.' For those who will wear his medal, he goes on, ***"I myself will obtain these souls the grace of coming to the belief of the Divine Truth of the Real Presence of Jesus Christ, the God-Man, in the Most Blessed Sacrament . . ."*** and ***". . . also that of conversion to the One True Faith of those souls, whom Christ loves dearly, who are presently estranged from Holy Mother Catholic Church."***

We received a letter recently from a homosexual man who had previously lain dying in a hospital from AIDS. He was angry and swore that he would never be reconciled with Jesus or the Church. His mother prayed the prayers of the Devotion for his conversion. Soon he asked to see a priest who visited him, patiently

listened to him and heard his confession. He got well enough to leave the hospital and to testify to others that he would die as a member of the Church which he peacefully did soon thereafter.

What we are being asked to do is simple – frequent Holy Communion and Eucharistic Adoration with reverence and awe. As St. Michael exhorts us, ***“Lift up your heads, see Who it is that you serve!”***

He went on, ***“I, myself, will accompany these souls who approach Our Lord in Holy Communion, with reverence, faith and LOVE. I will bear these souls upon my hands. I will watch over them with most special vigilance. I will be their special protector in their journey towards eternity. Let the faithful approach Our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament with love, devotion, and reverence. Let them at least desire these things.”***

St. Michael appeared to the visionary while she was in line to receive Communion at Mass. She said, *“He was quite tall. When my turn came, he motioned with his arm for me to go before him. He said that he would accompany me. As I rose and got in line, I felt St. Michael’s presence behind me, in a most protecting manner. Somehow he surrounded me from behind, ‘shielding’ me, again, as if to protect. As I approached Father, St. Michael bowed very reverently to Our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament and to His priest. After this, I was aware only of Our Lord.”*


